The International Relations Office organized the promotional event dedicated to the opportunities offered by the Erasmus Mundus programme on December 5, 2013.

The venue was the new space dedicated to students, and called "Cultural Flow Zone" in a central University library.

The event information was disseminated through:

- Post on the University International Facebook Page
- E-mail to all students
- E-mail to neighbour university international relations office inviting their students
- Posters in all the university buildings
- EM- ACE cards distributed in teaching spaces, libraries, cafeterias etc
- Announcement of the event at a previous event for students on international mobility ("Learn to Fly", November 27, 2013)

58 students registered for the event using the EM-ACE tool.

On the day of the event, around 35 students participated.

The agenda included presentations from the staff of the International Relations Office, and the contribution of EM students.

The presentations highlighted the programme in general, the projects currently ongoing at Ca' Foscari University (both for Action 1 and for Action 2), and further opportunities offered by the programme (special focus on TG2 funding opportunities).

The EM – ACE material was used: posters, cards and guides were printed, and the power point presentation was used, with some integration and modification, together with another presentation focusing on the EM projects of Ca' Foscari University.

After the presentations, there was time for questions from the students; to conclude, EM international students currently studying at Ca' Foscari were invited to comment on their experience and to give useful tips to potential candidates on how to prepare a successful EM application.

In conclusion, students showed a good interest in the EM programme, although it is evident that it is much less known than other education and training EU programmes.
